

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Happy Pentecost! This major feast of the church year represents God's "New Thing" being made in us and among us by the Holy Spirit. Pentecost is the last and 50<sup>th</sup> day of Easter. Another way to say this is that Pentecost is the first day after seven weeks of Easter (each week having of course seven days), corresponding to the biblical "Jubilee" (the completion of 7 x 7), which was a great spiritual, social, and economic reset button in ancient Israel. The Jubilee was a time to *make all things new* (Rev. 21:5), to wipe the slate clean, and engage life with fresh eyes and a light heart. The Jubilee was a time of renewal, just as the Pentecost event described in the *Acts of the Apostles* renewed the fervor of Jesus' disciples, "recreating" them through the power of the Holy Spirit.

Pentecost, then, is the perfect day for the first large grassroots event in our Strategic Visioning Process. This process will grow from our Pentecost event (see the "Special Insert" in this publication to learn more about our event on Sunday, June 5<sup>th</sup>!), involving a Strategic Visioning Team selected by our Wardens, Vestry, and me. This team will help the Vestry and me to analyze and create directives and goals from our work on Pentecost, and will help design another, final grassroots day in September, in which we will gather again to choose from among several courses of action and directives generated from Pentecost, helping to finalize our Vision for the next several years. You'll meet this Team soon and will receive regular updates on Strategic Visioning as the process progresses, culminating in a clear and actionable and achievable Vision after our September event occurring around the Feast of St. Michael and All Angels.

Just as was the case in the original Pentecost, every voice matters! This is not a "top-down" process, but rather a "bottom-up" process in which God's Spirit infuses all participants who open themselves to the experience of Jubilee. Let us celebrate this, our latest Jubilee—a time to honor what continues to enliven us, put down what binds us and no longer serves, and open our hearts and minds to the New Thing God is birthing through our common life as church together! As Jesus says, "Every scribe who has been trained for the kingdom of heaven is like the master of a household who brings out of his treasure what is new and what is old." (Mt 13:52). As we open the treasures, new and old, that God has placed in our hearts, let us offer them for the good of us all as we do the Pentecost / Jubilee work of crafting a holy vision together with God's Holy Spirit!

**On this year's Feast of Pentecost (Sunday, June 5) we will gather after each of our two morning liturgies in the Parish Hall for a one-hour experience in Strategic Visioning.** Every voice—and every Inspired Idea—is important for a best result from this foundational stage in our Strategic Visioning Process. This will be our own modern experience of the original Pentecost event! Please do participate!

In our hour together we will share our individual ideas for St. Catherine's future as well as work in a small group to help craft a vision of St. Catherine's that will determine our choices and use of resources for the next several years.

**Strategic Visioning is *not* a pop quiz!** Below, you will find the exact questions you will be asked... first, the questions around your individual input, and then the questions you'll be asked to discuss in a small group. Please start thinking about these as you can!

**Parish Life:** What kind(s) of events would best help us build a more vibrant common life over the next three years? Post all that apply:

### *Notes from the Senior Warden*

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

For a good part of the Great Fifty Days of Easter, I was away from St. Catherine's, "home" in Williamsburg, VA, visiting my father whose 86<sup>th</sup> birthday we celebrated, enjoying his company and that of my father's wife, my brother and his family. It was such a wonderful time, relaxing, yet invigorating, old and new memories, shared and made.



This coming Sunday is Pentecost! The "fiftieth day." Unbelievable. (They do say time passes more quickly the older we get)! After Jesus' death, resurrection and ascension, on the day of Pentecost, we welcome and celebrate the coming of the Spirit, the Gift of the Spirit, the fulfillment of the promise that Jesus gave.

During the reading of the lesson from the *Acts of the Apostles* which is read every Pentecost, we encounter the disciples, gathered together, all in one place. Suddenly, "from heaven there came a sound like the rush of a violent wind.... All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit," and began "to speak in in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability." This Sunday we will have a small sense of what that must have been like, hearing the rest of that lesson read in as many languages as possible, a cacophony of sound, deafening, affirming, uplifting, *renewing* – the effect of having received the Spirit.

We are called to respond to the gift of the Spirit - as the Spirit gives us the ability. Following each of our Pentecost services, with special provision for those unable to attend and/or participate this Sunday, we *all* will have the opportunity to participate in our Strategic Visioning, to share, in each of our voices, how we feel God has called us to live into our mission here at St. Catherine's. We hope you know that we value no voice more than another, and that **we want to hear from you all as we plan for our future.**

At this time of Pentecost, the "Feast of Weeks," in the words of Henri Nouwen, may "we make the life of the Spirit within and among us all we think, say or do."



# AROUND ST. CATHERINE'S

## *Notes from the Treasurer*

Attached with this article is the St. Catherine's financial data through April 2022. We can see the detailed data for the month of April along with the data "year to date" through April. The information displayed here is a reflection of the parish performance to the operating budget for our parish. Not included here are the "Restricted" fund expenses and revenues. Such items as the recent roof replacement, weekly flowers and other designated expenses are not included in the operating budget.



For the month of April, pledge revenue was (\$9,100) under budget with total revenue (\$8,773) under budget. Good news is that total expenses were also (\$4,053) under budget which gives a total deficit for April of (\$4,720).

Year to date info shows that pledge revenue is (\$14,580) under budget with total revenue (\$17,156) under budget. Data also reveals total expenses for the year are also under budget (\$9,031). This leaves a net deficit to budget year to date of (\$8,125).

Although we are operating at a deficit to the budget through April, St. Catherine's had ample cash reserves at beginning of the year to tolerate the deficit. It is anticipated that deficit spending to the budget will continue for most of this current year. The parish is budgeted to move some funds from earnings in the endowment in 2022 which will occur later this year. This revenue will help with the deficit to budget as we move forward.

It is important for our parishioners to remain current with the pledge commitments for 2022 as we move into the summer months of our calendar year.

## AROUND ST. CATHERINE'S

### **OPPORTUNITIES WITH ST. CATHERINE'S ENDOWMENT AND MEMORIAL FUND**

After a brief respite because of COVID, St. Catherine's Endowment and Memorial Committee is back up and running. The Committee's name perfectly describes its mission – to create an income-generating endowment that provides money for capital improvements outside of St. Catherine's annual fiscal budget, and to provide opportunities for parishioners to create permanent memorials for loved ones. St. Catherine's has had some modest success with its endowment fund. For example, the endowment fund recently paid for the new roof on the church.

Tax deductible contributions to the endowment fund can be made at any time. However, many people find it advantageous to provide for St. Catherine's in their will, estate plans, or as a beneficiary designation on any financial accounts. Everyone should have a will to minimize the hassle of the probate process after a death. If there is no will, the State of Florida by law provides one for you. However, St. Catherine's will not be an allowed beneficiary if someone dies without a will. In order to provide for an endowment bequest to St. Catherine's, you must make an affirmative step of either putting St. Catherine's in your will, or as a beneficiary to a financial account like an IRA or brokerage account.

The opportunities for memorials are literally endless. Virtually any part of the church or its mission can be the benefit of a memorial to a loved one. The Committee will provide further information on endowment / memorial opportunities within St. Catherine's. However, we wanted to let you know that like St. Catherine's itself, the Committee is energized to provide a more stable financial footing for St. Catherine's presently, and far into the future. ## Children's Chapel Reopening

We are seeking volunteers to be leaders in Children's Chapel. THE GOOD NEWS is that volunteers would participate ONE Sunday a month and there is NO LESSON PLANNING as it is all prepared for you. We serve in teams of three: the Worship Leader, the Music Leader, and the Motions Leader. (Don't worry, the motions are all written out for all the songs that have motions.) Additionally, the nursery workers and children join and participate in Children's Chapel.

Children's Chapel is for children up to the age of 8 or 9. This service is on Sundays from 10 AM until the time of the Passing of the Peace in Adult Church. Our purpose is to introduce children to praising God and appropriate church behavior through songs with motions, stories and of course, prayers. Since we include our nursery children, the older children act as role models for the younger ones. When Children's Chapel is over, the nursery children return to the nursery, and the older children are escorted to church, to join their parents.



Motions for Songs!

St. Catherine's, the diocese and Episcopal Church are concerned for the safety of our children. All volunteers must complete a background check and the diocesan course "Safeguarding Online."

The plan is to begin offering Children's Chapel during August, as this will give our volunteers time to do the child safety things and become familiar with the materials and songs, so that everyone can help with the singing. We are so excited to be able to have Children's Chapel — it has been a long 2+ years. Our children have not been limited in their ability to participate and be an active part of our faith community.
